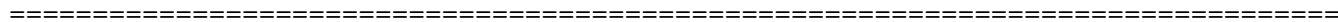

The logbook includes notes on shipboard occupations; at least one death; and punishment of the merchant mariners on board. During its voyage, the Friendship spoke the brigantines Aurora (out of Plymouth) and Fly (out of Baltimore); the schooner Fame and the ship Nancy Hollowell, both out of Kennebunk (Maine).

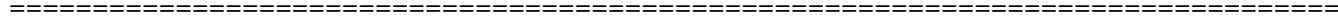

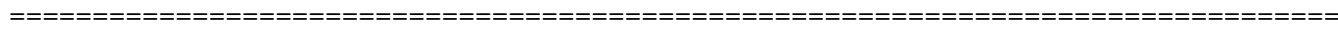
